IRISH WHISKEY – Bushmills Distillery

Gls 35.3ml

Bushmills Distillery, County Antrim

Famed for holding the oldest license to distill in the world, Bushmills is also the oldest operating distillery in Ireland. Their triple distilled single malt is made from unpeated barley giving a soft, smooth and well-rounded whiskey that is typically Irish in character.

Bushmills Millennium Single Cask 1975, 25 year old

€25.00

Very hard to find, this whiskey was originally only available to private investors buying a whole barrel! The 25 year has been matured in a bourbon cask giving a lovely creamy, malty taste with some hints of nuts and spice.

Bushmills 1608 Millennium, Cask Strength, 1982

€21.00

This whiskey is even rarer than the 1975 Millennium edition. Very fruity and soft with flavours of sliced pineapple, pears and creamy vanilla fudge.

Bushmills Single Malt, 21 year old

€19.00

Matured for a final 'finishing' in Madeira casks. This malt has a wonderful nutty, raisin and fruit cake character. Very complex, warming and beguiling

IRISH WHISKEY – Tullamore Distillery

Gls 35.3ml

Tullamore D.E.W., County Offlay

Tullamore Dew is the original triple distilled, triple blend whiskey. Tullamore D.E.W. is named after Daniel E. Williams, the man who decided that true craft could only come from the True Character and insisted that his whiskey was made accordingly.

Tullamore, 12 year old

€7.00

A high proportion of sherry cask ageing gives this whiskey plenty of body and a lovely rich and spicy flavour. A well balanced and satisfying finish.

Connemara Peated Single Malt

€6.00

Sweet and smoky on the nose, very enticing. More sweetness on the palate with some vanilla and honey leading to peat smoke and fruity flavoured finish.

Middleton Distillery, County Cork

Home to Irish distillers, Middleton is the biggest and most productive distillery in Ireland producing many of the well-known names in Irish whiskey. It was opened in 1975, when it took over production from Irish Distillers' old premises in Cork and Dublin. Middleton specializes in producing pot still whiskey and grain whiskey.

Middleton Very Rare**€28.00**

Blended from whiskeys aged from 12 to 27 years, Middleton is complex and incredibly smooth to taste with flavours of honey, ginger, malt, dried fruits and vanilla.

Jameson, Special Reserve**€20.00**

Initially released in 1995 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the first transatlantic radio broadcast. Like Jameson Gold some virgin oak casks were used in the aging giving flavours of honey, hobnobs and cornflakes.

Jameson 1780, 18 year old**€19.00**

The fullest and richest tasting in the Jameson family with plenty of hidden depths. Spicy, sherry and toffee flavours give way to a sweeter more chocolaty finish.

Redbreast Limited Release, 15 year old**€16.00**

Unchilfiltered and bottled at 46%. This is Redbreast with the volume turned up to eleven. Thicker, spicier and altogether bigger than the 12 year old with a finish that goes on forever.

Jameson Gold**€15.00**

A blend of casks up to 20 years old with a proportion aged in virgin oak. Essentially a more rounded and mature version of Jameson Marconi with some lovely honey, vanilla, malt and clotted cream flavours.

Jameson 1780, 12 year old**€26.00**

Sweet and gentle to taste with a palate that is dominated by spicy amoroso sherry and oily pot still notes. The finish is very mellow with a hint of chocolate.

Powers Special Reserve, 12 year old**€10.00**

Aged solely in Bourbon wood. This is a soft and smooth whiskey with vanilla, honey, malt and biscuity flavour. Only available in Ireland.

Redbreast Pure Pot Still, 12 year old**€10.00**

A legendary Irish whiskey, Redbreast is packed full of complex spice, sherry, toffee and Christmas cake flavours with a full-bodied oily texture.

Greenspot Pure Pot Still**€8.00**

One of the few Pure Pot Still whiskeys currently available. This style of whiskey is unblended and made from both malted and un-malted barley. Fresh and light with flavours of tropical fruits and vanilla.

IRISH WHISKEY – Cooley Distillery

Gls 35.3ml

Cooley Distillery, County Louth

This new-ish distillery started production in 1989. Cooley is the only Irish producer that practices double distillation. Some of the whiskeys here are also made from peated malt giving a smoky flavour reminiscent of some of the smoky west coast malts from Scotland.

Cooley Peated Single Malt, Cadenhead Bottling, 12 year old €12.00

An incredible nose reveals damp bonfire smoke, Hessian and a touch of sea air. Sweet smoke to start on the palate with some harmonious peppery spice and a fruity finish.

Cooley Peated Single Malt, Cadenhead Bottling, 10 year old €12.00

Assertively smoky on the nose with hints of crème caramel. The palate is powerful and immediate with pungent peat smoke, spice and vanilla flavours.

Greenore Peated Single Grain, Limited Edition, 8 year old €6.00

Made from corn rather than barley. Pronounced aromas reminiscent of a pure pot still whiskey. Flavours of vanilla milk shake, honey cedar and spice.

Cooley Single Malt, Signatory Bottling, 10 year old €6.00

Fresh fruit, vanilla and malt on the nose. Sweet and very fruity on the palate with pear drops, fresh green apples and creamy vanilla flavours.

IRISH WHISKEY – Kilbeggan Distillery

Gls 35.3ml

Kilbeggan Distilling Company (County West Meath)

The Kilbeggan Distillery is the oldest licensed distillery in Ireland. Dating back to 1757.

Tyrconnell Single Cask No. 3177 €9.00

A very enticing aroma of Christmas cake, spice and fruit. Smooth and rich to taste with more spiciness balanced by the typical Cooley sweet fruit flavours. A good long finish gives the whiskey a very Moorish quality.

The Spirit Safe Cooley 1991, Peated Single Malt, 12 year old €11.00

Pungent aromas of wet smoke, sea air and vanilla. Lots of honey flavours on the palate with a persistent smokiness more vanilla and a touch of fruit.

Lockes Limited Edition Single Malt, Pure Pot €9.00

Limited to a production of 5000 bottles. Typically fruity with flavours of fresh fruit salad, honey and malt.

Tyrconnell Limited Edition, Pure Pot €9.00

Limited to just 5000 bottles and bottled from specially selected casks. Citrusy and fresh to taste, uncomplicated and charming with a lively character.

Lockes Single Malt, 8 year old €6.00

Extremely well balanced, much like a good Speyside single malt. Malty and soft to taste with layers of honey, sweet grassy flavours and a touch of coffee.

SCOTCH WHISKY - Speyside / Islay / Highland / Island**Gls 35.3ml****MaCallan, 25 year old (Speyside)****€16.00**

Surprisingly gentle and mildly smoky on the nose. The great palate is wonderfully complex with great interplay between spicy sherry cask influenced flavours and more fruity bourbon barrel enhanced characters. Velvety smooth and delicious.

Lagavulin 16 Year Old (Islay)**€11.00**

Powerful, almost aggressive nose with lots of peat smoke and sea spray aromas. Full bodied and oily in texture with more smoke, herbal, grassy notes and a slightly salty tang.

Oban, 14 year old (Highland)**€10.00**

A lot of coastal sea influence on the nose with hints of sea spray, peat smoke and malt. Firm and full bodied on the palate with ripe fruit, seaweed and smoke flavours.

Glenlivet, 15 year old (Speyside)**€12.00**

Soft and flowery aromas with a fruity and fresh palate. Flavours of ripe peach, vanilla, chocolate and white flowers.

Glenmorangie, 10 year old (Highland)**€8.00**

Invigorating and light with a suggestion of sea air. The palate is complex and well balanced with soft malty, buttery and creamy flavours.

Talisker, 10 year old (Island)**€8.00**

Pungent, big and well rounded. Smoky and malty flavours combine with a wonderful peppery, sweet and sour character.

Cragganmore, 12 year old (Speyside)**€8.00**

Often admired for having the most complex aroma of any malt. A very satisfying and well-balanced style with flavours of herbs, flowers, spice and sweet malt.

Dalwhinnie, 15 year old (Highland)**€9.00**

Enticing aromas of heather, honey and cut grass. The palate is delicate and malty with good flavour development leading to a sustained and gently smoky finish.

Chivas Regal, 12 year old (Blended)**€7.00**

this is a very refined blended whisky, with herbs, honey and fruit leaping forth on the palate.

Glenfiddich, 12 year old (Speyside)**€7.00**

Fresh and fruity on the nose, while the palate starts with a malty sweetness and finished with well-developed white chocolate and toasted hazelnut flavours.

Glenkinchie, 10 year old (Speyside)**€7.00**

Softly aromatic with aromas of flowers, lemon grass and sweet lemon. Light in body with flavours of soft spice, Demerara sugar, oak and ginger.

Bowmore, 12 year old (Islay)**€8.00**

The most popular Islay malt in its native Scotland! Rich, full bodied style with a great balance of sweetness, peat smoke and sea influences.
